Direct Care Workforce Survey

Pursuant to [2020-009, L.O.F.](#), the Agency has implemented a survey of direct care workers to be completed by the following licensees upon application for renewal licensure: Nursing Homes licensed under part II of chapter 400, Assisted Living Facilities licensed under part I of chapter 429, and Home Health Agencies and Homemaker/Companion Service Providers licensed under part III of chapter 400. This survey is **mandatory per section 408.822, FS.**, and is **only** available through the Agency's [Online Licensing System](#) as part of the renewal application for the above licensees.

The purpose of the survey is to collect information on different categories of direct care workers defined in section 408.822, FS. This includes the number of direct care workers, related vacancy and turnover rates, wages, employment benefits and related costs, and availability of training.

Applying online can save you time and money, and helps save paper. Applicants must register an [AHCA Portal](#) account to apply online. If you are not already registered to apply online, click the link and follow the instructions to sign up: [Access Online Licensing](#).
